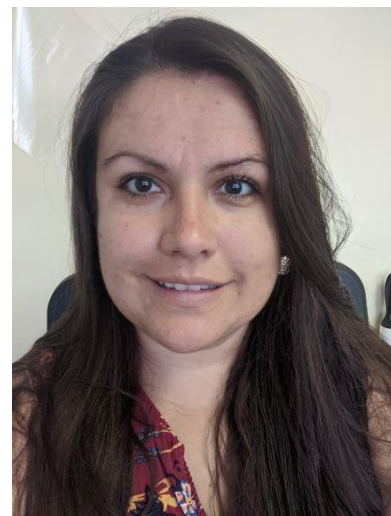
Hi! **My name is Ana Karina Torres, but I prefer Karina** because that is what my family calls me.
